




Institutional Roofing












Gutters

TPO

Thermoplastic polyolefin (TPO) systems are single-ply roofing membranes and continue to be the most popular choice for business and home owners with low slope systems. TPO offers several important benefits including:

The TPO roof is resistant to breakdowns, corrosion, and abrasions of any kind. In addition, their heat-welded seams are extremely strong, adding to the durability of the TPO roof.

Low Maintenance


The strength of the TPO roofs makes them easy to maintain, requiring minimal repairs.

Built-up

Because the elements and traffic can take their foll on some areas of even the best roofs, the second, third, and fourth layers ensure worry-free protection. Pickard Roofing's attention to detail truly sets our built-up roofs apart. We often include copper flashings and surfacing, which together improves premature failure due to corrosion. This means our built-up roof can provides as much as 40-50 years of protection.



In addition to traditional built-up roofing, we also install modified bitumen roofs when the odors associated with asphalt are an issue. This type also serves well in high foot traffic areas in commercial situations.

EPDM

EPDM, or ethylene propylene diene terpolymer rubber roofing has been popular for its high performance. Pickard Roofing has seen this performance first-hand, after installing countless EPDM roofing systems on commercial buildings across the Triangle.

Here are a few issues to look for during inspection:

Signs of Leaks

Check for leaks regularly. Look in your attic for signs of water stains. Next, look at your ceilings. Finally, check the chimney flashing for signs of water intrusion.

Clogged Gutters & Downspouts

Clean all leaves, dirt, and debris out of your gutters regularly. If left alone, they can prevent water from draining properly, and cause a variety of problems.

Loose or Missing Shingles

North Carolina summers cause extreme heat on the roof. Nails can pop, and shingles can shift or lift. Chances are if you find one loose shingle, you'll find more.

Debris

Look for piles of leaves, sticks, twigs and other debris on the roof

Caulk

Inspect the caulk around flashing and seams. Look for cracks and missing caulk.

Flashing

Flashing should be rust-free and clear of cracks and corrosion.

Soft Spots

Dips or soft spots are an indication of rot or structural trouble beneath the surface.

Water or Ponding Stains

Water and mud stains indicate that water has been puddling, either around the drainage pipes or in other areas.

General Wear and Tear

Roofing materials age at different rates. We can estimate the useful life of your roof system, as well as prevent premature failure.
